The form will be sent to the Publisher by two different methods. This is the corresponding author's responsibility to take written permission from co-authors.

Conflict of Interests

In the interests of transparency and to help readers to form their own judgements of potential bias, authors must declare any competing financial and scientific interests in relation to the work described. The corresponding author is responsible for submitting a competing interest statement on behalf of all authors of the paper. This statement must be included in the cover page (first page) of submitted article file. The corresponding author will also be required to indicate the existence of a competing interest as part of the submission process.

Human and Animal Rights

For articles in *Plant Omics* reporting experiments on live vertebrates and/or higher invertebrates, the corresponding author must confirm that all experiments were performed in accordance with relevant guidelines and regulations. The manuscript must include a statement identifying the institutional and/or licensing committee approving the experiments, including any relevant details, in the methods section.

For experiments involving human subjects, authors must identify the committee approving the experiments, and include with their submission a statement confirming that informed consent was obtained from all

subjects.

For clinical manuscripts that include identifying information relating to participants (including patients' details, images, or videos), written informed consent for their publication must be obtained from the participants or their parent or legal guardian. This documentation must be provided at the time of submission.
